A **paragraph** is a group of **sentences** about **one main idea**. When you read, you can spot a paragraph easily. The first line may be indented (beginning a little to the right of the others). Otherwise, space separates from other paragraphs, like the paragraphs on this page. When you write, be sure to indent each of your paragraphs.

Readers expect each paragraph to stick to one idea. A paragraph usually contains a **Topic Sentence** that tells what that **main idea is**. The rest of the sentences support, or explain, the topic sentence.

There are four main types of paragraphs: **Descriptive, Expository, Narrative, Persuasive**.
