

HOW MUCH do we know about crocodiles?

Crocodiles are (1) **dinosaurs / carnivores**. They eat fish, birds and other animals. They have long (2) **horns / tails** that help them swim. Crocodiles are very (3) **loud/ quick** in the water and on land- they can swim and run at 15km per hour. They can also make (4) **loud / quick** sounds.
