


## Do You Know Which Phylum These Animals Belong To?

#### Across:

- I have no body cavity but have simple excretory system consist of protonephridia.
- The most successful phylum with tagmata and highly developed sensory organs
- Filter feeders with choanocytes "collar cells" and commonly known as sponge.
- All organisms in this phylum have a cnidocytes, a stinging cell at the tentacles. Dimorphism which have 2 body forms ; sessile polyp and motile medusa.
- Psedoceolomate with an elongated cylindrical body with two tapered ends.
- Have notochord, dorsal hollow nerve cord and pharyngeal cleft.

#### Down:

- Have a hard calcareous endoskeleton (1st endoskeleton animal) and water vascular system.
- Have 3 body parts; muscular foot, visceral mass and mantle.
- Means "little rings", have metameric segmentation and excretory system consist excretory tubes called metanephridia.
