SINGULAR REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

A **REFLEXIVE PRONOUN** shows that the action is done by and to the same person.

These are singular reflexive pronouns:

myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself

Singular reflexive pronouns refer to a singular subject.
