

Past simple

Trecutul simplu este cel mai obisnuit timp verbal folosit pentru a povesti despre lucruri care s-au intamplat.

I. UTILIZARE

Se foloseste de obicei cu adverbe/expresii care fac referire la trecut:

- **YES/YESTERDAY** ieri
 - e.g. Mark arrived yesterday.
- **LAST ... night/week/month/year** seara/saptamana/luna/anul....trecut/trecuta
 - e.g. They bought the house last year.
- **two weeks/three days....AGO** acum doua saptamani/trei zile
 - e.g. Mary called me two weeks ago.
- **Se specifica exact cand s-a intamplat actiunea:**
in 2015/in February/at the end of last month... when I was little/when I was in France in 2015/in februarie/la sfarsitul lunii trecute cand eram mic/cand am fost in Franta

II. FORMARE

Se formeaza cu forma a doua a verbului de conjugat. Din punctul acesta de vedere, verbele in limba engleza se impart in doua:

- **VERBELE REGULATE** sunt cele care formeaza a doua forma prin adaugarea lui **-ed** sau **-d** la sfarsitul formei de baza:
 - Work – worked
 - Listen – listened
 - Finish – finished
 - Move – moved
 - Love – loved
 - Like – liked

Anumite verbe sufera transformari atunci cand se adauga **-ed** sau **-d**:

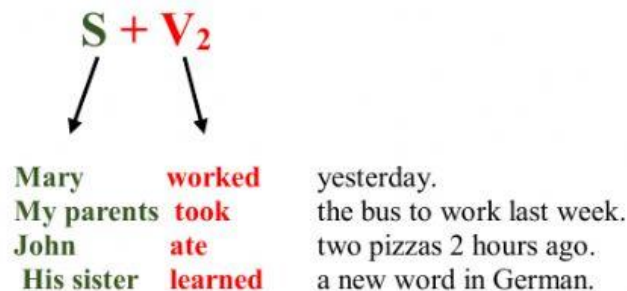
- Cand un verb se termina intr-o vocala+consoana, consoana se poate dubla cand se adauga **-ed**:
e.g. stop – stop**ped**
plan – plan**ned**
 - Daca un verb se termina in **consoana+y**, **y** se transforma in **i**
e.g. cry – cried
try – tried
- Daca verbul se termina in vocala+y, y nu se transforma:
- e.g. play – played
enjoy – enjoyed

- **VERBELE NEREGULATE** sunt cele pentru care nu exista o regula in ceea ce priveste formarea celei de-a 2-a forma. De aceea exista liste cu verbe neregulate, pentru a usura invatarea acestora.

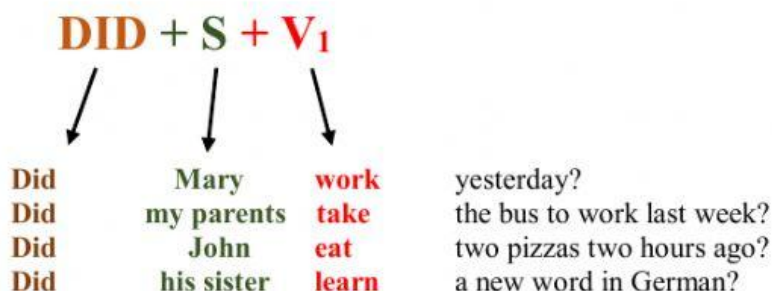
- **AFIRMATIV**

Pentru a forma o propozitie afirmativa la trecut nu avem nevoie decat de subiect si a doua forma a verbului de conjugat



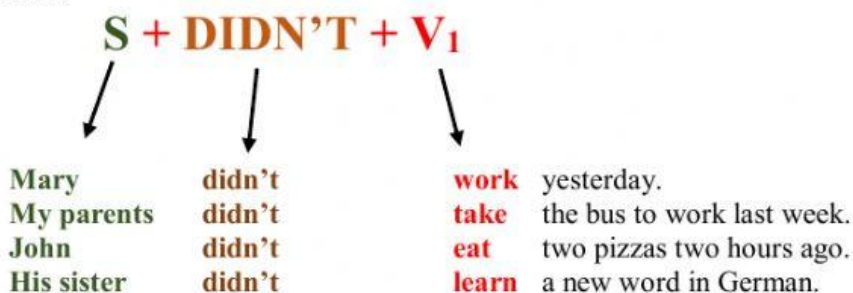
- **INTEROGATIV**

Pentru a forma intrebari, se foloseste **DID** la inceput de propozitie, ceea ce determina ca verbul de conjugat sa treaca la **prima forma**:



- **NEGATIV**

Pentru a forma propozitiei negative, se adauga **DIDN'T** inainte de verb, ceea ce determina ca verbul de conjugat sa treaca la **prima forma**:
