

Present Perfect Simple

1. Simone **has lived** in her home for eight years.

A. Something that happened **at some point in the past**. We don't know exactly when and it is **not important**.

2. She **has built** a studio, a games room and a movie theatre.

B. An action which **started** in the past and **hasn't finished**. It **continues** in the **present**. We also know the **duration** of the action, **how long**.

3. Simone **has seen** the world's best cities, **has met** a lot of important people and **has eaten** some unusual food.

C. A **life experience** – to talk about **people, places, events**.

Affirmative

Person + **have / has** + 3rd form

3rd form =

Regular verbs: + ED (play → played)

Irregular verbs: third column in the table (eat → eaten)

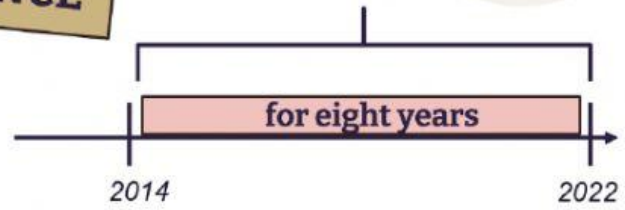
