

# REAL CONDITIONALS



## ZERO CONDITIONAL

- ✓ STRUCTURE : IF + PRESENT SIMPLE, ...PRESENT SIMPLE.
- ✓ USAGE : to talk about things that are always true, like scientific facts.

## FIRST CONDITIONAL

- ✓ STRUCTURE : IF + SIMPLE PRESENT, ... WILL/WON'T + V-BF
- ✓ USAGE: to talk about possibilities in the present or future.
