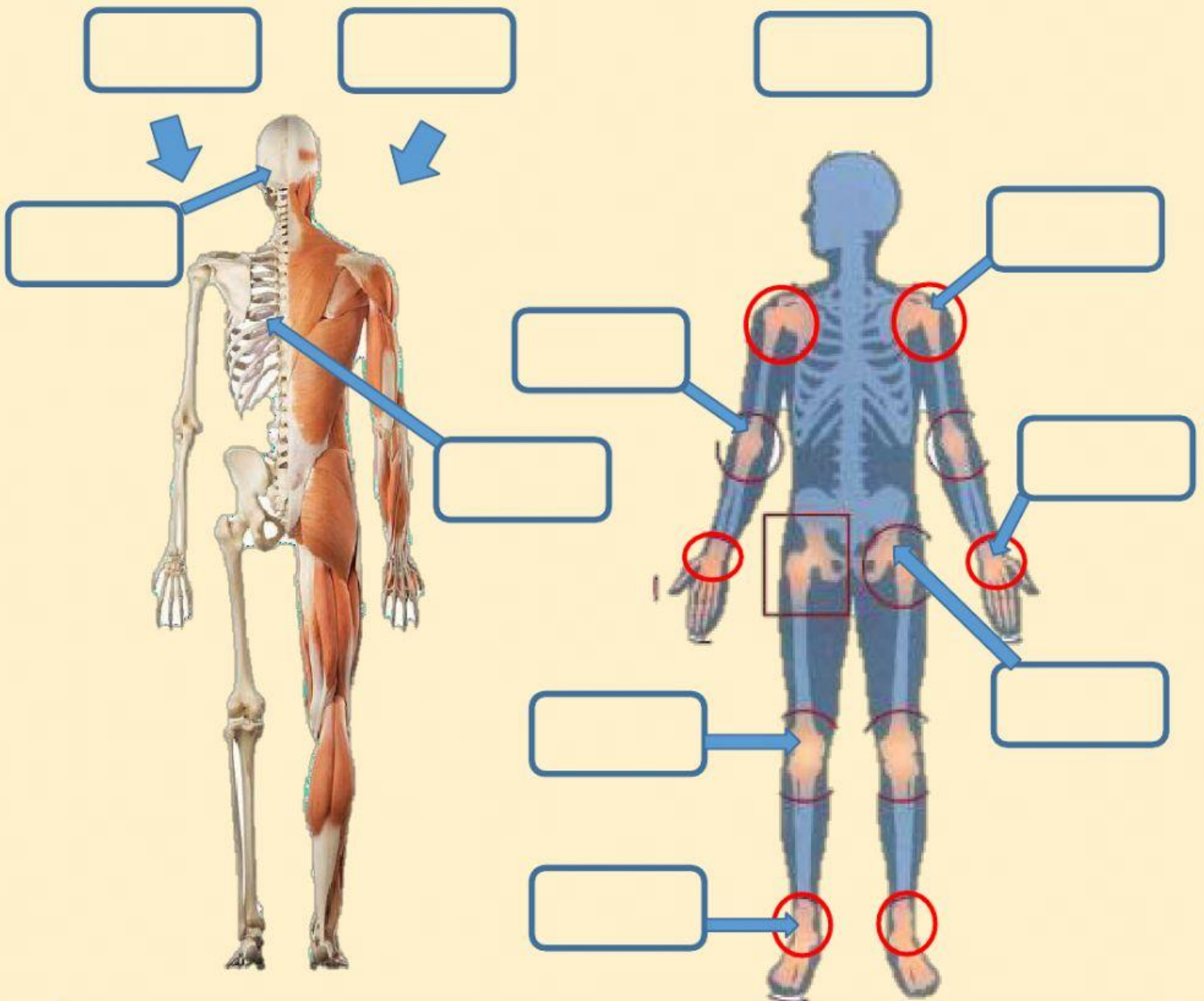


THE LOCOMOTOR SYSTEM

The locomotor system makes our body move. It's made up of **bones**, **joints** and **muscles**.

- _____ = We have 206. They are hard and rigid. Some bones protect organs. The **skull** protects the brain. The **ribs** protect the lungs and heart.
- _____ = We have over 600. They are elastic and flexible.
- _____ = Joints are where two or more bones meet. The main joints are: **neck, shoulder, elbow, wrist, hip, knee and ankle**.

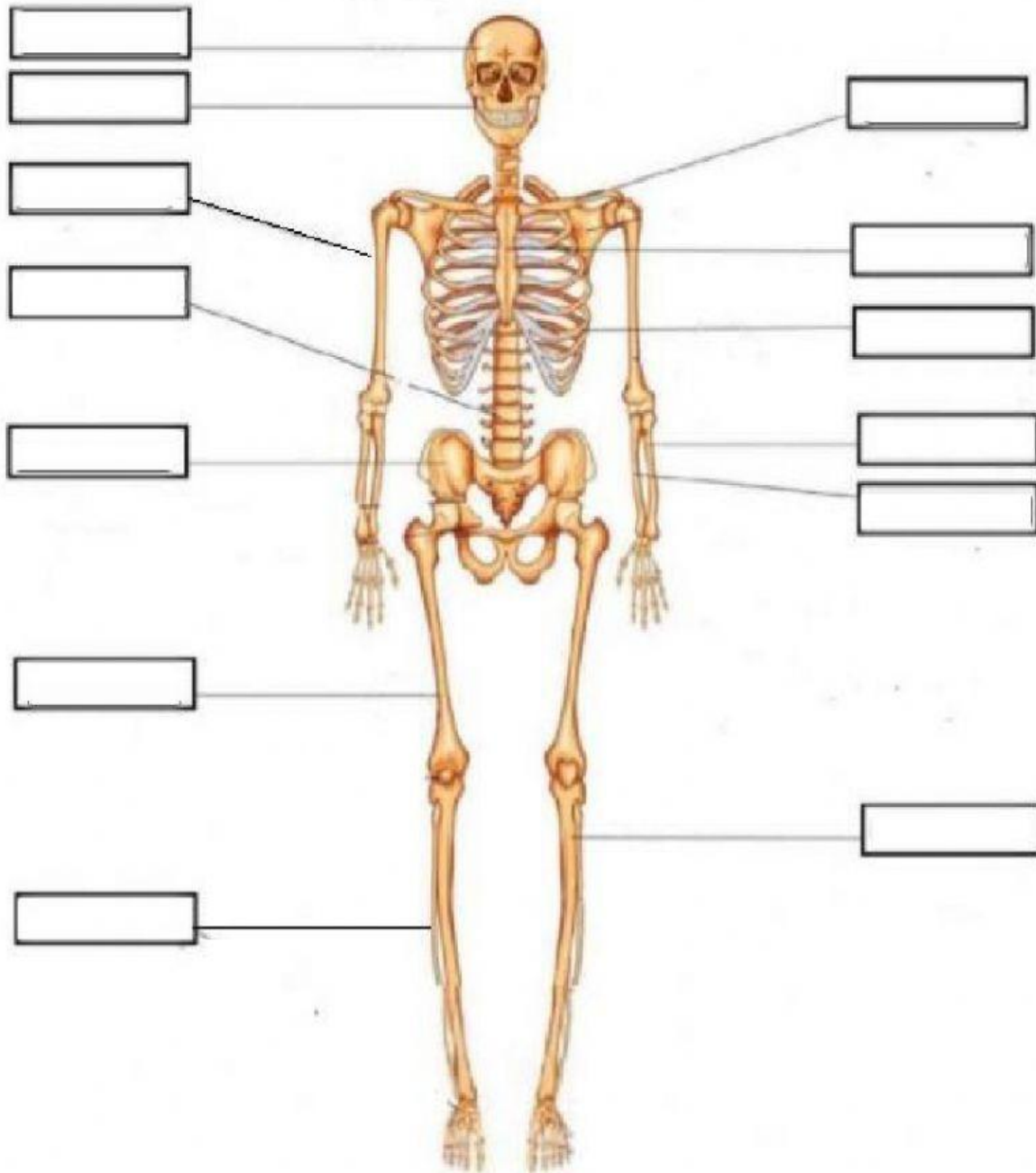

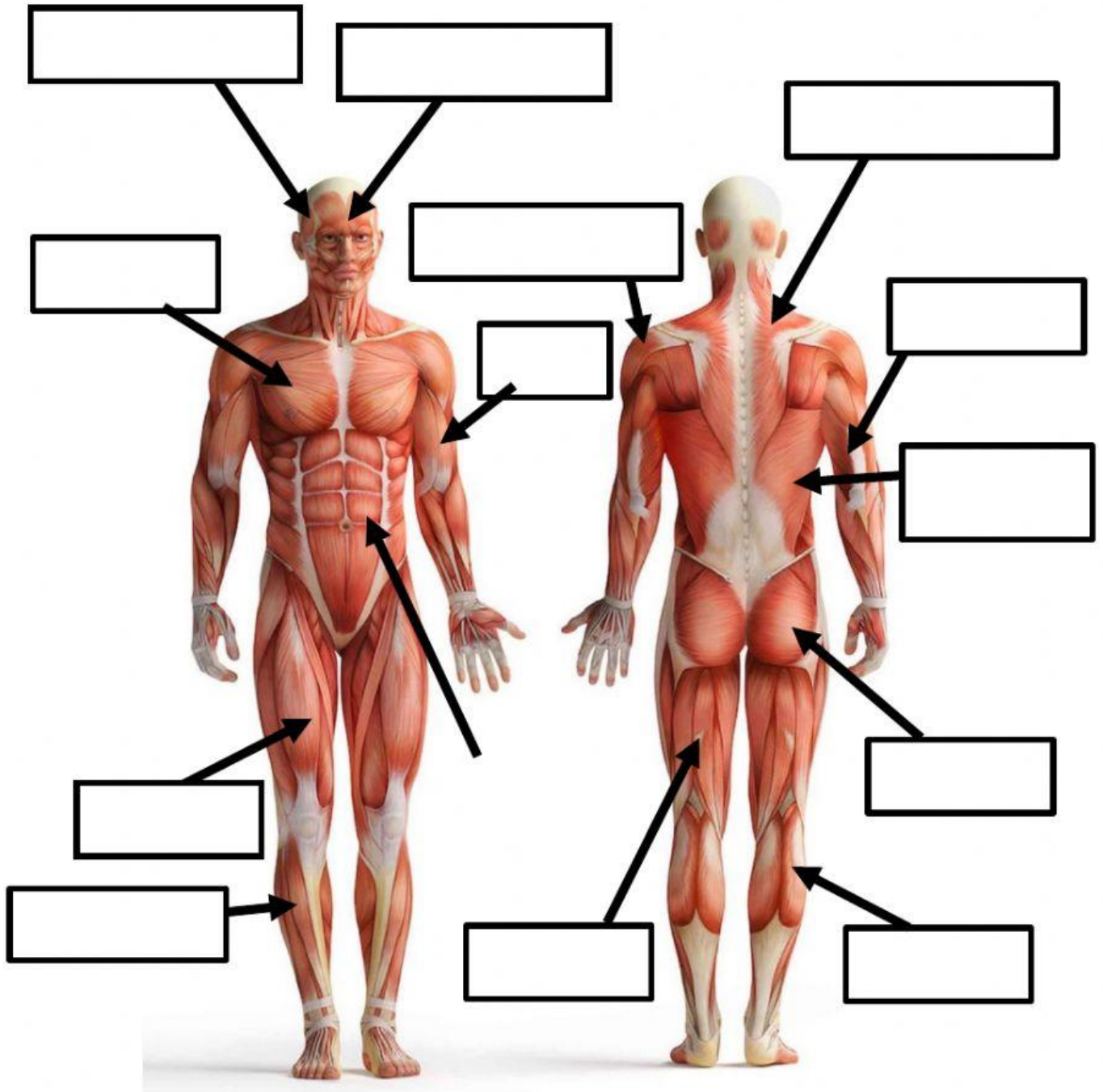
