

Comparative and Superlative Adjectives

The **comparative** is used when you are comparing two things, and is made by adding an *-er* or the word *more* before an adjective.

The **superlative** is used when you are referring to the highest quality or degree of something, and is made by adding *-est* or the word *most* before an adjective.
