We use **some** in *positive* sentences: (There is **some** milk. There are **some** oranges)

We use **any** in *negative* sentences and *questions*:

(There isn't **any** milk. There aren't **any** oranges.)

(Is there **any** coffee? Are there **any** pears?).

****BUT**** We use **some** when we *offer things*: (Would you like **some** tea?)

****** Or *ask for things*: (Can I have **some** coffee, please?)
