Selena Gomez, an American actress and singer, was born in Texas in 1992. In 2002, at the age of ten, she had her first acting experience in a television series. In 2003, while she was playing in the television series, she also got a role in the film *Spy Kids 3-D*. In 2007, Selena got a leading role in the American comedy series, *Wizard of Waverly Place*. Selena played a teenage girl in a family of wizards who had a restaurant in New York. The series was so popular that ten million people watched its final episode. In 2009, the series received an award and made Selena a famous television star.

In 2008, Selena recorded the song *Fly to your Heart* for the film *Tinker Bell*. In the same year, she got a role in the musical film *Another Cinderella Story*, for which she also recorded three songs. At the age of 16, she formed the pop band, called *Selena Gomez and the Scene*. Selena chose four men to be in her band. The group made three successful albums, but in 2013, Selena decided to stop the band because she wanted to work as a solo artist. Since then, she has sold more than 7 million albums worldwide and has won a lot of awards.

Selina also works in the fashion industry. In 2010, she worked with famous designers to produce her first fashion line called *Dream Out Loud*. In 2014, she released *Selenators*, a collection of clothes for school students. The clothes of Selena's collections are expensive, but they are made from recycled or eco-friendly materials which do not harm the environment. Selena has also participated in many charity organisations and has tried to help people in need.
