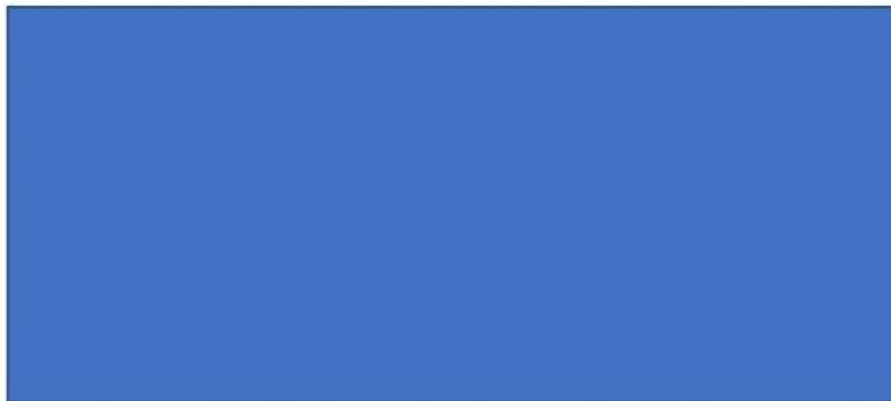
1. "Was Tom there when you arrived?"
