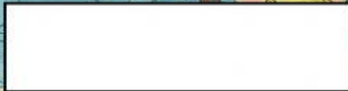
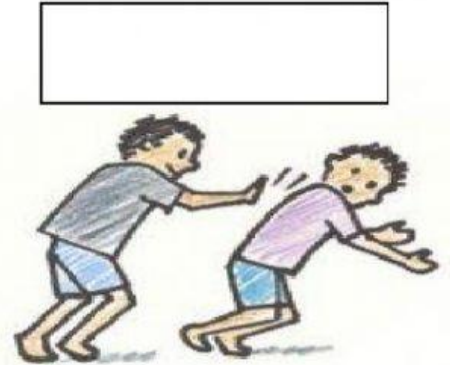


## Being Nasty. Bullying.
