

### Weather forecast for Wednesday

There is a large area of low \_\_\_\_\_<sup>1</sup> moving towards the UAE from the east, which will reach the east coast of Fujairah and Ras Al Khaimah early on Wednesday morning.

There will be \_\_\_\_\_<sup>2</sup> in the morning across the Northern Emirates due to the drop in temperatures. Fujairah and Ras Al Khaimah will be hit first with the strong \_\_\_\_\_<sup>3</sup> brought in by the low pressure system and, once the moisture-laden \_\_\_\_\_<sup>4</sup> begin to cross land and rise over the mountainous areas, it will begin to rain heavily.

The low pressure system will continue to travel westwards towards Sharjah and Dubai, bringing further \_\_\_\_\_<sup>5</sup>, blustery conditions and even a chance of thunderstorms and \_\_\_\_\_<sup>6</sup>.

There will be strong winds with \_\_\_\_\_<sup>7</sup> of up to to 50 kph onshore resulting in decreased visibility due to blown sand and dust. However, the north-westerly winds will be stronger \_\_\_\_\_<sup>8</sup> with speeds of about 65 kph, leading to waves as high as 4.5 metres in the Arabian Gulf and the Gulf of Oman.
