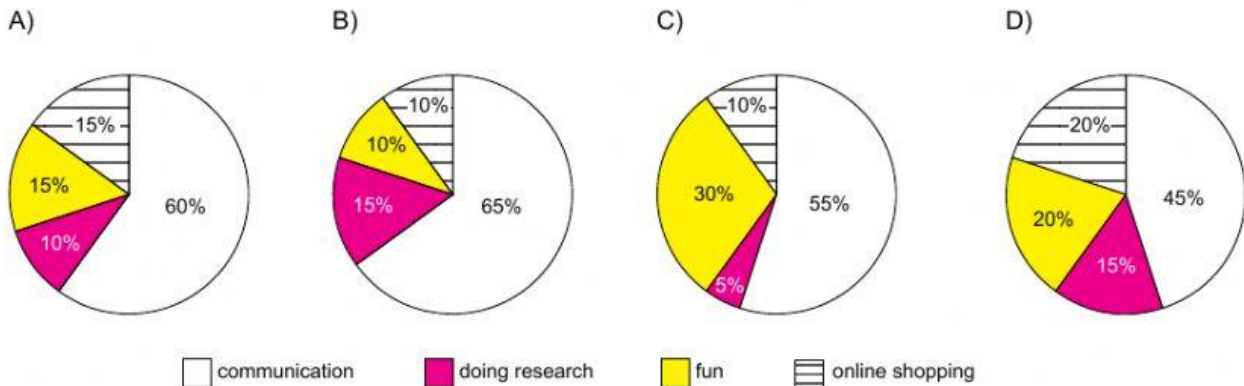

**Scott** : You're welcome. Please get your ticket before the concert.

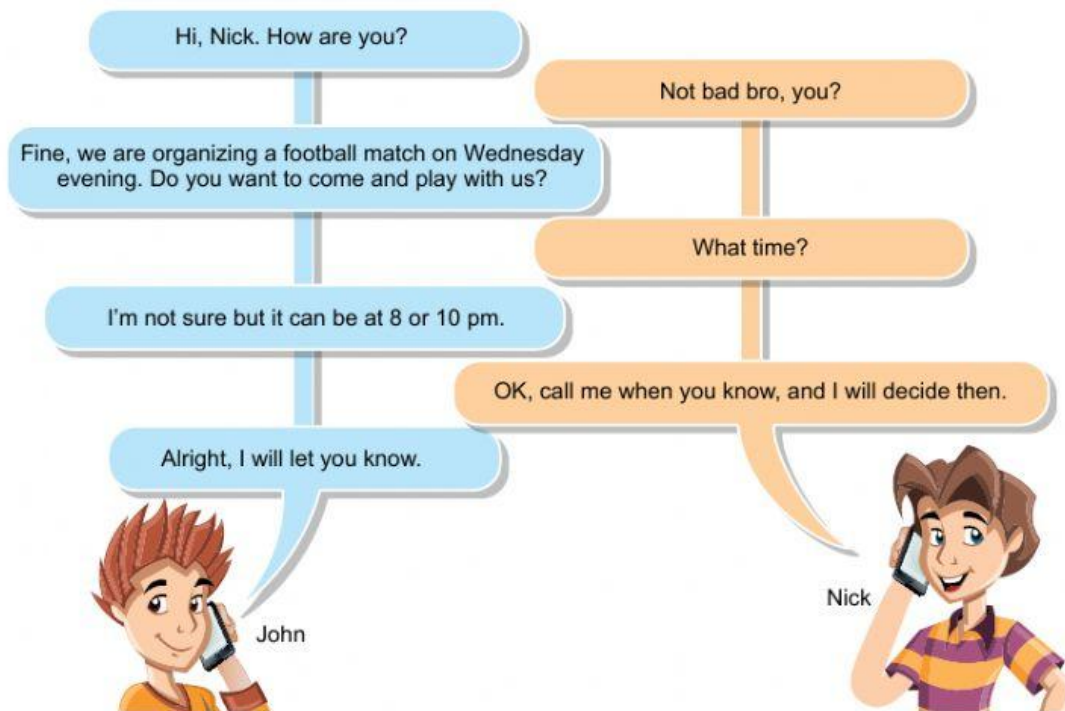
