Nowadays, there are a lot of jobs young people can choose from. There are two types of jobs in the world of work.

The first is called blue collar job, or physical work where you don't need a college or university (1)..... to do it. For example, to be a carpenter, car repairer, electrician or plumber, you have to go to a vocational school or to a special course or training.
