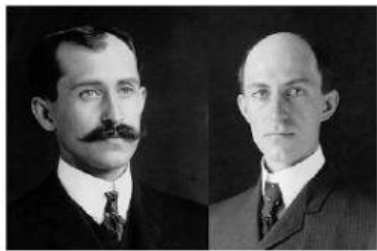
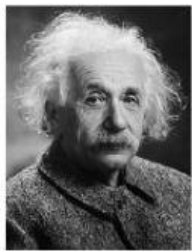

Grammar

We use the past simple to talk about the past. We know **when** these things happened. The Past Simple is the same for all subjects:

I/You/He/She/It/We/They worked yesterday.

Regular verbs: spelling rule	Examples
most regular verbs: add -ed	started; worked; stayed; finished wanted
regular verbs ending in -e: add -d	lived; hated
regular verbs ending in consonant + y: - y ⇒ -i and add -ed	studied; married
regular verbs ending in consonant + vowel + consonant: double the last consonant	stopped
