Ratih	: Thanks, Bagas. I hope so.




Zebras and horses are hoofed mammals belonging to the horse family. Zebras can be found in savannas, grasslands, thorny scrublands, woodlands, hills and mountains of Africa, while domesticated horses can be easily found all over the world. Zebras and horses share many common features, but they can be easily differentiated by taking notes of several things.

Horses on average are bigger and more powerful than zebras. Zebras range from about 4 to 5 feet in height where horses can get up to around six feet in height. Zebras have stockier, donkey-like body. They are lighter than horses.

Zebras have larger and more rounded ears than horses. Horses have long legs, much longer than the upper part of the body, while zebras have shorter legs that are roughly equal in size with the upper part of the body. Zebras have smaller and more oval hooves that are harder than horse's hooves.

Horses are faster than zebras. They can run a much longer distance than zebras. However, zebras can be more agile than horses due to their size. So, it is easier for them to move their bodies in any situation. Even though they are slower, zebras can easily escape from their fierce predators by running in a zigzag manner.
