| Phoenicians | Their culture contained elements of both Celtic and Iberian culture |
| Greeks | They founded Empuries (Ampurias) and Rhode (Roses) |
| Carthaginians | Their language derived from the Tartessian language |
| Tartessos | They founded the city of Gadir (Cádiz) |
| Turdetani | It was located at the mouth of the Guadalquivir River |
| Iberians | They were from Carthage, located in northern Africa |
| Celtiberians | They created a large empire that lasted from 753 BC to 476 AD |
| Romans | They occupied the Mediterranean coast as of 1100 BC |
