a = length of side (*lado*)

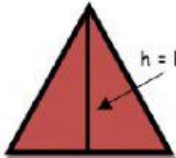
Area of square = a^2

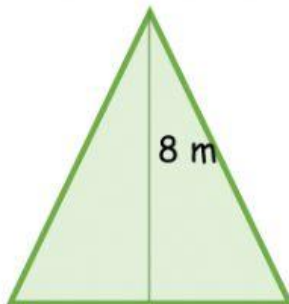

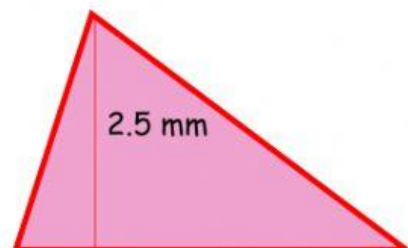
