LOOK at the name of the story and the pictures.

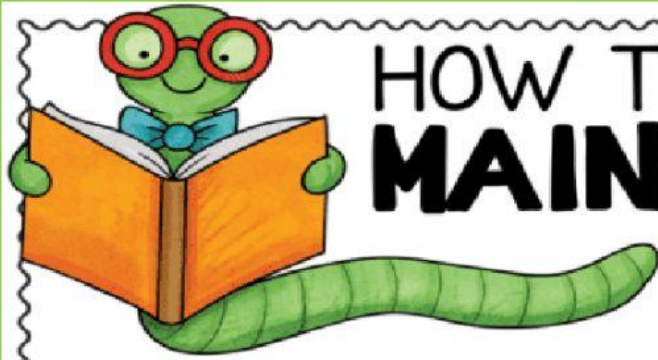


CLUE WORDS are words used over and over.

HOW TO FIND MAIN IDEA

BEFORE YOU READ:

- ☐ Read the title.
- ☐ What is the text about?
- ☐ What is the topic?

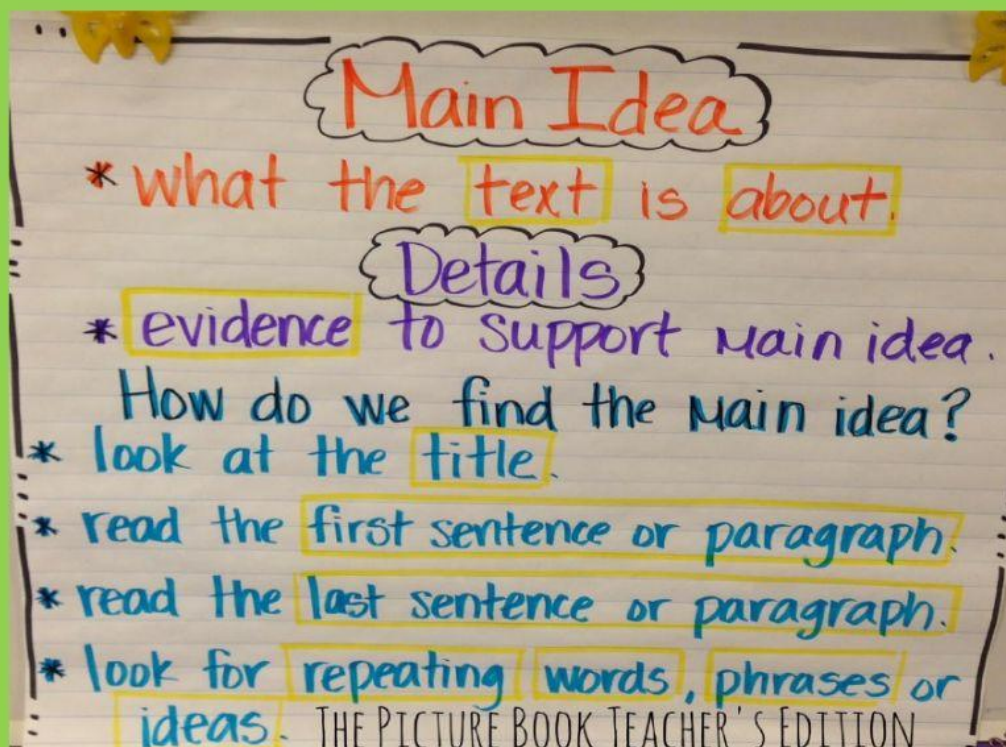
DURING THE READING:

- ☐ Look for and carefully read text features.
- ☐ Is the text fiction, non-fiction...
- ☐ Look for information, words, and pictures that are repeated.

AFTER YOU READ:

- ☐ Think about the most important point about the topic.
- ☐ What details or examples back up and support the main idea?

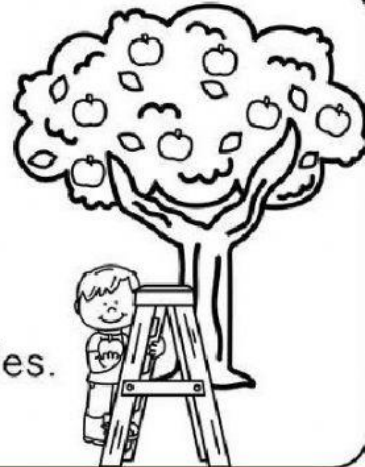


I have an apple tree.
