Synthesis and Transformation

Direct Speech

These are the exact words a person or character in a story says. It is always used with quotation marks.

Example

"You'll never guess who I just met!" exclaimed Henry.

Indirect Speech

These are the words that a person or character in a story says but not their exact words. It is also called Reported Speech. We never use quotation marks for indirect speech.

Example

I told my mother that I did not like to eat vegetables.

Tense

When we change a sentence from direct to indirect speech, the tense of the sentence needs to change accordingly. Refer to the rules below.

Rule 1

If the sentence is in present tense → change to past tense

Example

He said, "I **live** in Tampines." → present

He said that he **lived** in Tampines. → past

Practice 1

"He is my best friend," Tommy said.

Rule 2

If the sentence is in present continuous tense → change to past continuous tense

Example

He said, "The dog **is walking** on the road." → present continuous

He said that the dog **was walking** on the road. → past continuous

Practice 2

"I am visiting my friend next week," Sarah told me.

Rule 3

If the sentence is in present perfect tense → change to past perfect tense

Example

He said, "I **have lived** in Tampines for two years." → present perfect

He said that he **had lived** in Tampines for two years. → past perfect

Practice 3

Jerry said, "I have visited many countries in Europe."

Rule 4

If the sentence is in present perfect continuous tense → change to past perfect continuous tense

Example

He said, "I **have been studying** since morning." → present perfect continuous

He said that he **had been studying** since morning. → past perfect continuous

Practice

"I have been living by myself for the past three years." Jackson claimed.

Rule 5

If the sentence is in past tense → change to past perfect tense

Example

He said, "I **arrived** ten minutes before Judy." → past

He said that he **had arrived** ten minutes before Judy. → past perfect

Practice 5

He told his mother, "I wanted to go to the zoo."

Rule 6

If the sentence is in future tense → change only the modal verb to past tense

Example

He said, "I **will go** to school." → future

He said that he **would go** to school. → past

Practice 6

Sandy said, "I'll be home at around 3pm."
