The <sup>1</sup>st\_\_nn\_\_ng Dingle Peninsula, sticking out into the Atlantic Ocean, is one of the most <sup>2</sup>d\_\_l\_\_ghtf\_\_l regions in Ireland. Only 320 km from Dublin, it is famous for its <sup>3</sup>s\_\_gn\_\_f\_\_c\_\_nt archaeological sites and is one of the least densely populated areas in the country. Castlegregory (population 205!), located on the north coast between Tralee and Dingle is <sup>4</sup>p\_\_rf\_\_ct for walking. From its summit, you can enjoy <sup>8</sup>br\_\_ \_\_t\_\_ht\_\_k\_\_ng views of the Blasket Islands, a tiny group of islands just off the coast. However, due to its closeness to the Atlantic, you might experience bad weather conditions as the weather can change suddenly, so make sure you're warmly dressed!
