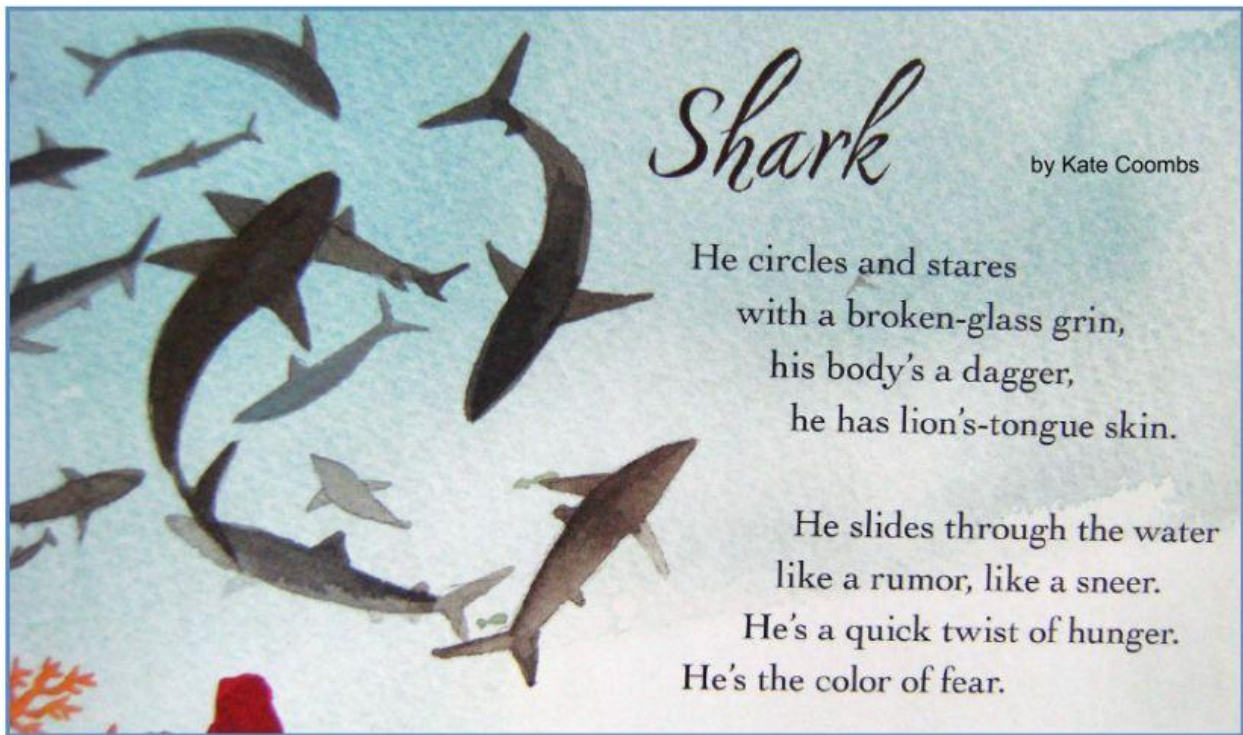




Shark
