Earth's Revolution



As the Earth rotates on its axis, it also moves in a path around the Sun. The path where the Earth takes around the sun is called its Orbit. One complete orbit around the Sun is called a revolution. The Earth takes about $365 \frac{1}{4}$ days or 1 year to make one revolution.

In the calendar there are usually 365 days in one year. Every four years, we add an extra day making 366 days in total. The year that has an extra day added is called a Leap year.
