San Diego Zoo, California, USA, is one of the most famous zoos in the world. With about 4,000 animals of more than 800 different species, it's the largest collection of exotic and endangered mammals, birds and reptiles.

The zoo opened on New Year's Day in 1923.

It is famous for its colony of koalas. There are also big groups of pandas, giraffes, hippos, bonobos (pygmy chimpanzees) and Galapagos tortoises. You can walk through a tropical rainforest, a river habitat with tigers and gorillas, and a polar bear habitat with chilled pools.

There is a special section for children and several services to help people with disabilities to visit the zoo.
