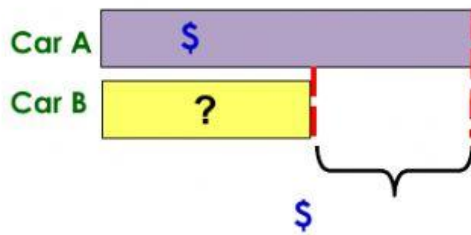
1) The price of **Car A** is **\$52 790**.

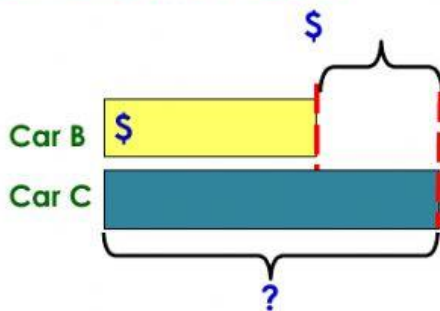

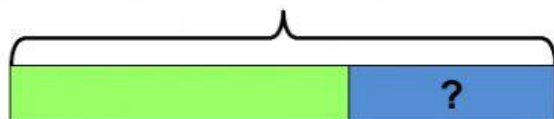

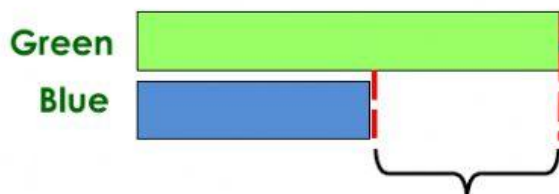
