

VERTEBRATES.

We can classify vertebrates in 5 groups:

	▪ Mammals have got <u>hair</u> or <u>fur</u>. ▪ They breathe with <u>lungs</u>. ▪ Most of them have got <u>four legs</u>. ▪ They are born from the <u>mother's womb</u> and they feed their babies with milk. VIVIPAROUS.
	▪ Birds have got <u>feathers</u>. ▪ They breathe with <u>lungs</u>. ▪ They have got <u>two legs</u> and <u>two wings</u>. ▪ They lay <u>eggs</u> to reproduce. OVIPAROUS.
	▪ Fish have got <u>scales</u>. ▪ They breathe with <u>gills</u>. ▪ They have got <u>fins</u> to swim. ▪ They lay <u>eggs</u> to reproduce. OVIPAROUS.
	▪ Amphibians have got <u>moist skin</u>. (piel húmeda) ▪ Young amphibians breathe with <u>gills</u>, adult amphibians breathe with <u>lungs</u>. ▪ Adult amphibians have got <u>four legs</u>. ▪ They lay <u>eggs</u> to reproduce. OVIPAROUS.
	▪ Reptiles have got <u>dry skin with scales</u>. ▪ They breathe with <u>lungs</u>. ▪ Some reptiles have got <u>four legs</u> (crocodile), but some have no legs (snake). ▪ They lay <u>eggs</u> to reproduce. OVIPAROUS.
