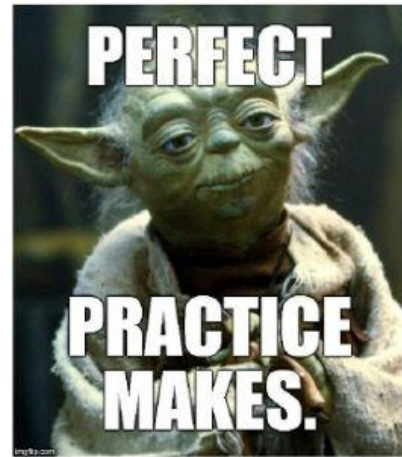
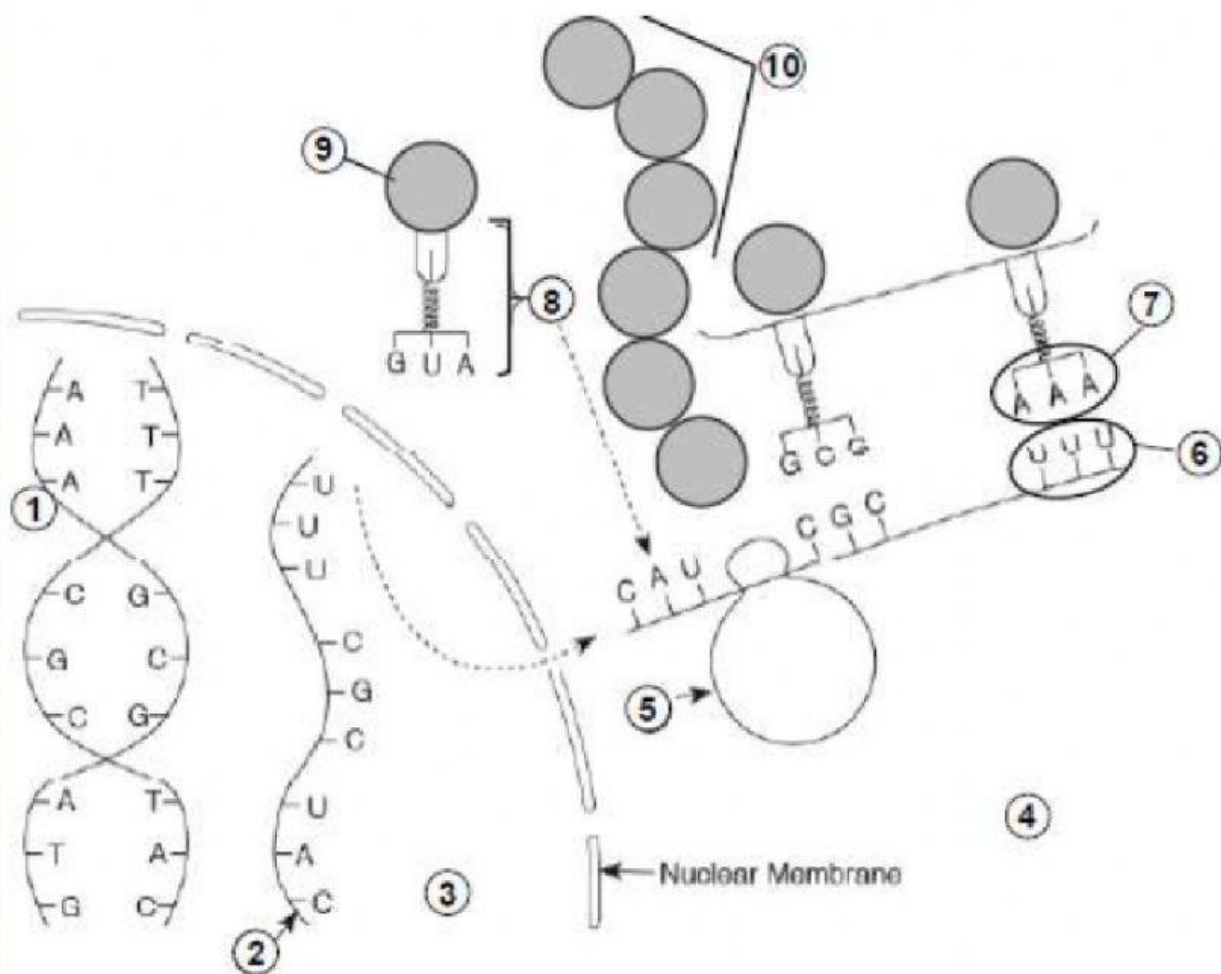

Part 1: Interpreting Diagrams

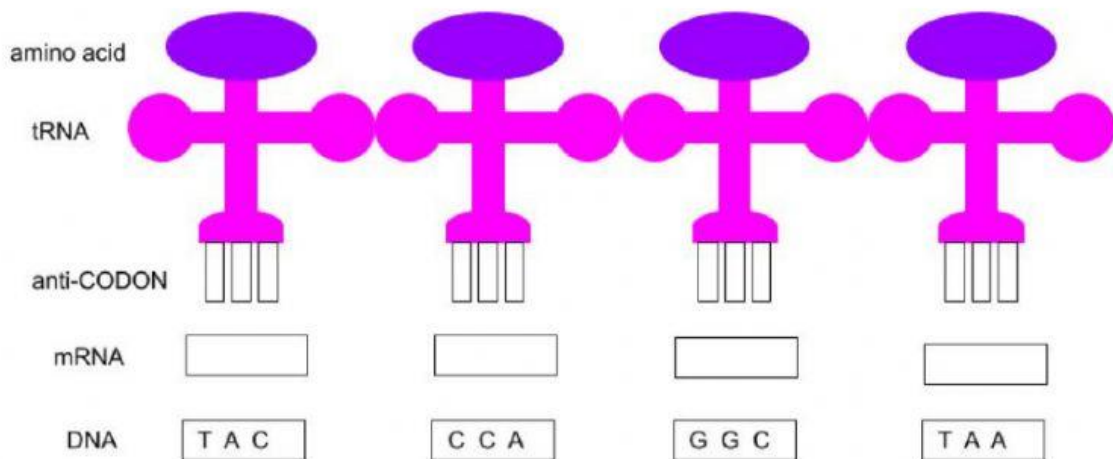

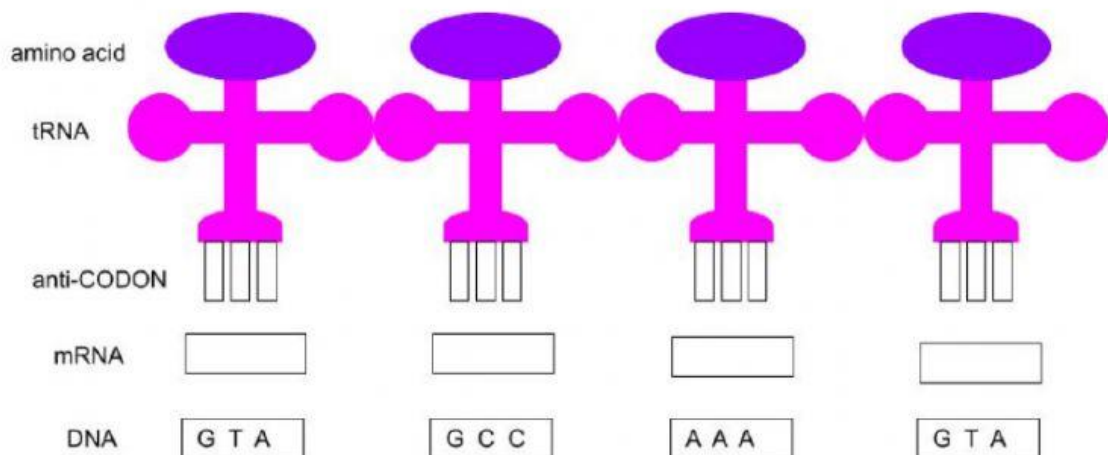
Part 2: DNA to Amino Acids

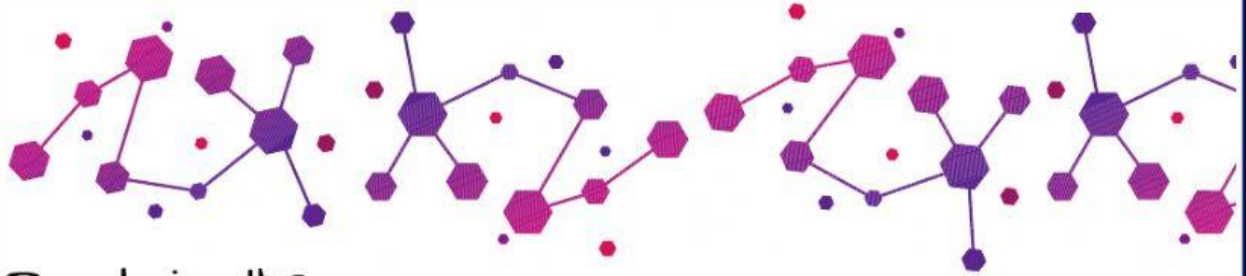
Chains of amino acids linked together make a polypeptide - another word for 'protein'. Practice using a codon chart to determine the amino acids for each protein you are making.

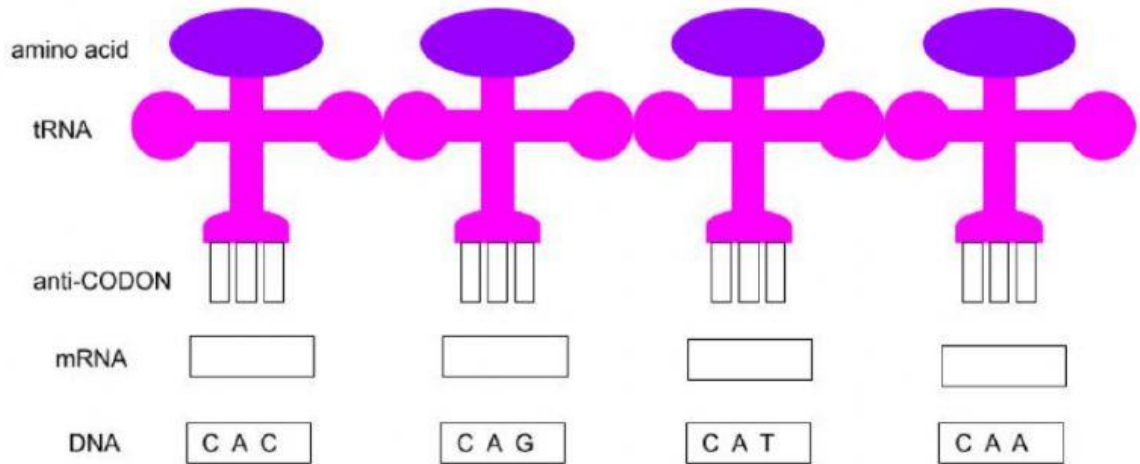

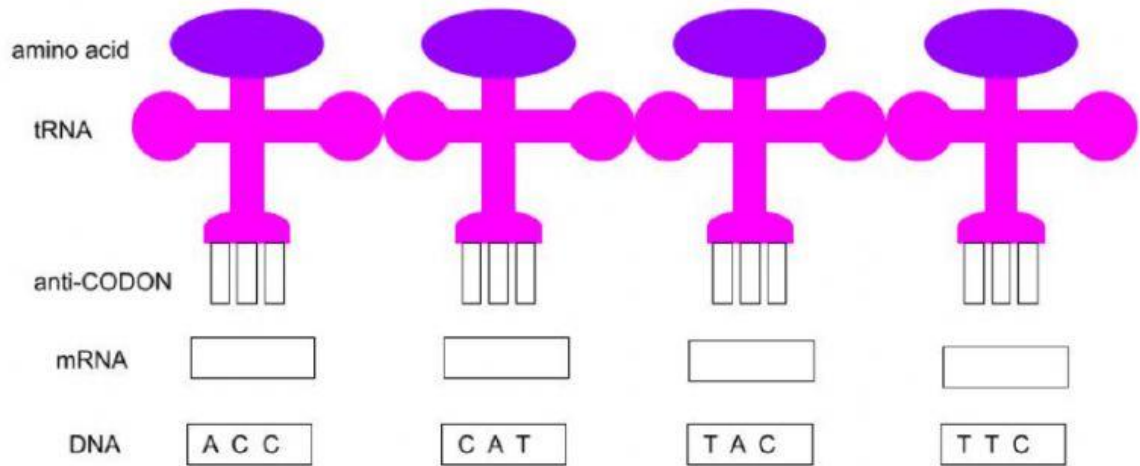
