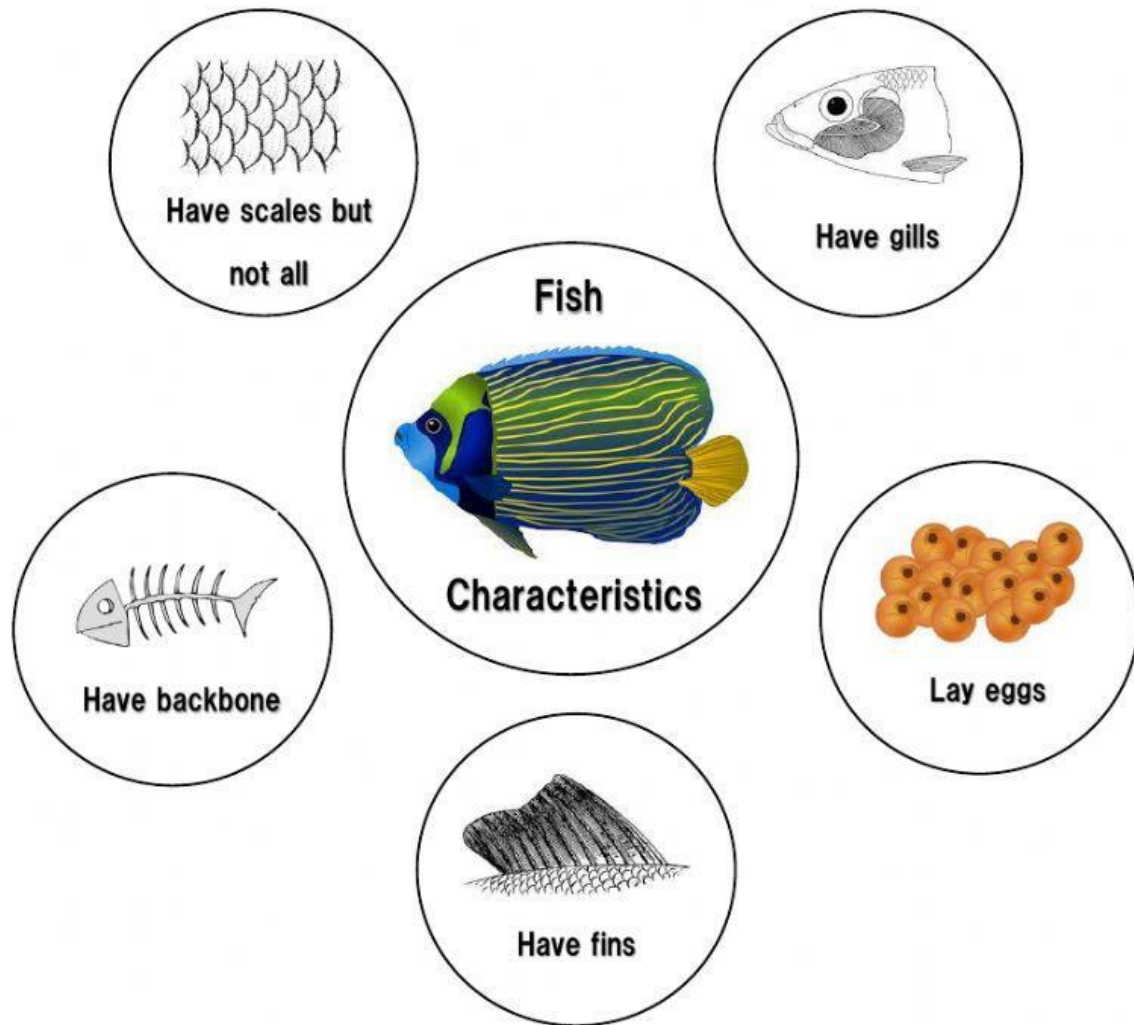

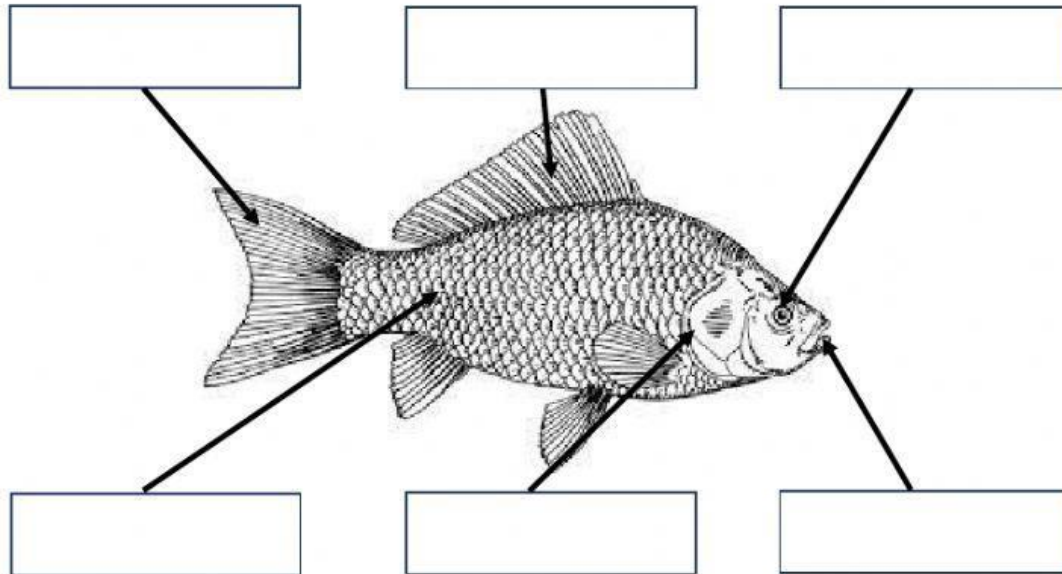


• FUN FACT
