

PRESENT SIMPLE: YES/NO questions

Simple present with verb TO BE

Verb TO BE		Subject		Complement
Am		I		happy?
Are		You		happy?
Is		He/She/It		happy?
Are		We		Happy?
Are		They		happy?

Answers: AFFIRMATIVE

Yes, I am.

Yes, you are.

Yes, he is/Yes, she is/Yes, it is.

Yes, we are.

Yes, they are.

Answers: NEGATIVE

No, I'm not.

No, you aren't.

No, he isn't. /No, she isn't. /No, it isn't.

Yes, we aren't.

Yes, they aren't.

Simple present WITHOUT the verb TO BE

Auxiliary DO		Subject		Main Verb
Do		I		read?
Do		You		read?
Does		He/She/It		read?
Do		We		read?
Do		They		read?

Answers: AFFIRMATIVE

Yes, I do.

Yes, you do.

Yes, he does/Yes, she does/Yes, it does.

Yes, we do.

Yes, they do.

Answers: NEGATIVE

No, I don't.

No, you don't.

No, he doesn't. /No, she doesn't.
/No, it doesn't.

Yes, we don't.

Yes, they don't.
