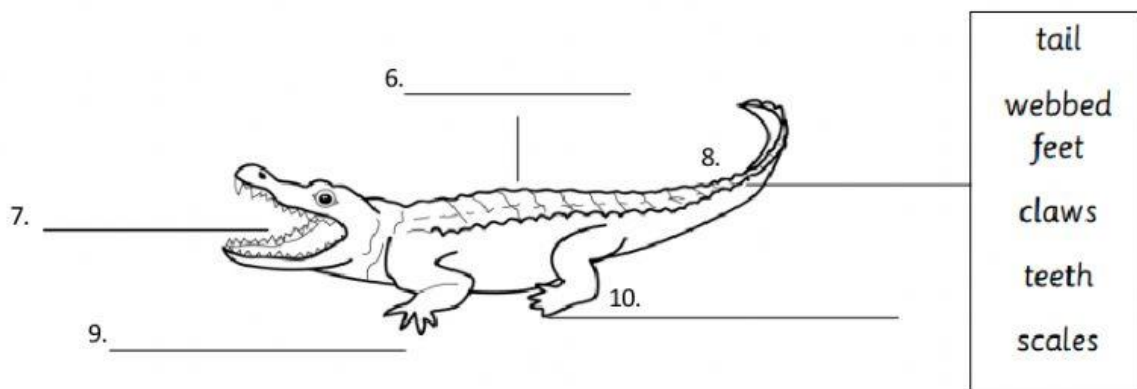

A water monitor is a large lizard. It is a reptile. It lays eggs and has cold blood.

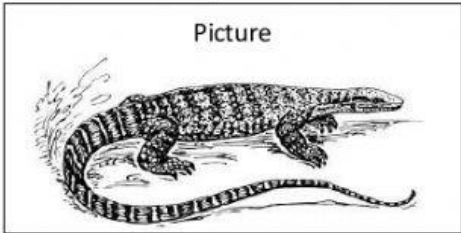
