IF AN ADJECTIVE ENDS IN "Y":
DELETE THE "Y" • SUBSTITUTE IT WITH AN "I" • ADD ER



PRETTY - PRETTIER

Mary is
prettier than
Jane.



LAZY - LAZIER

My neighbor's cat is
lazier than
my cat.



HEAVY - HEAVIER

That box is
heavier than
this box.



NOISY - NOISIER

Main Street is
noisier than
Third Street.

ONE CONSONANT • ONE VOWEL • ONE CONSONANT.
DOUBLE THE CONSONANT AND ADD ER.



BIG - BIGGER

My dad's bike is
bigger than
my bike.



HOT - HOTTER

Your soup is
hotter than
my soup.



MEAN - MEANER

Cooper is
meaner than
Duke.

Buddy.

my house.
