#### Non-sentences and Sentences(Telling and Asking)

##### What is a Non- Sentence?

**Non-Sentence** – are group of words that does not express a complete thought or idea. It **begins** with a **small letter** and does not **end** with a punctuation mark.

Examples:

the red heart

two stars

my sister

the yellow box

##### What is a sentence?

**Sentence** are group of words that expresses a complete thought or idea. It starts with a capital letter and ends with a punctuation mark.

Examples:

The heart is red.Liza is my  
sister.

My teacher gives me two stars.The toy is  
in the yellow box.

#### Punctuation Marks (.) (?) (,) (') for Telling and Asking Sentences

Eyes Here:

There are types of sentences as we knew, the most common are:

**A. Telling Sentence** - are sentences that relay information, state the facts or opinion. Simply tell the readers about a persons, things, places and animals. It starts with a capital letter and end with a period (.).



Examples:

The heart is red.

Liza is my sister.

My teacher gives me two stars. The toy is  
in the yellow box.

**B. Asking Sentence** – are sentences that just simply ask questions. It starts with a big letter and ends with a questionmark (?). It comprises the WH questions (Who, What, Where, When, Why and How).

Examples:

What is the color of the heart?

Who gives you two stars?

Who is your sister?

Where can we find the toy?

**Punctuation Marks** – are symbols we can find at the end of a sentence.

(.)- Telling Sentences (?) - Asking  
Sentences

Examples:

1. What is the name of your father?
2. My father is Ricardo Cano .
