

Using the three degrees of comparative adjectives



The positive adjective- e.g. Mark is tall.

The comparative adjective- e.g. Peter is taller **than** Jim.

The superlative adjective - e.g. Mark is **the tallest** boy.

In the box provided, type in the correct form of the adjective at the end of the sentence to complete the sentence.

Remember to-

add **than** after comparative adjectives

e.g. Peter is than John. (young)

Peter is **younger than** John. (young)

add **the** before superlative adjectives

e.g. Peter is of all the boys. (young)

Peter is **the youngest** of all the boys. (young)
