Remember, for one syllable adjectives that end with the letter 'y', replace the letter **y** with the letter **i** then add **er** or **est**.

Remember to-

add **than** after comparative adjectives

e.g. A flea is an ant. (tiny)

A flea is **tinier than** an ant. (tiny)

add **the** before superlative adjectives

e.g. Bacteria is of all living things. (tiny)

Bacteria is **the tiniest** of all living things. (tiny)
