

Using the three degrees of comparative adjectives

Remember, for one syllable adjectives that end with a short vowel sound followed by a consonant, **double up** the consonant then add **er** or **est**.

In the box provided, type in the correct form of the adjective at the end of the sentence to complete the sentence.

Remember to-

add **than** after comparative adjectives

e.g. Tim is his brother. (slim)

Tim is **slimmer than** his brother. (slim)

add **the** before superlative adjectives

e.g. Ann is girl of them all. (slim)

This is **the slimmest** girl of them all. (slim)
