



Movie maker websites

If you want to make your own movies at home, then (1) **go** / **went** to a movie maker website and find out what to do.

These websites have everything you need to create your own cartoon movies. You (2) **can** / **could** choose from three basic characters, and there are different sections for action clips, feelings and places. First of all, you (3) **have to** / **had to** choose a character and a place, and then the frame appears in your movie. (4) **If** / **Where** you want, you can change the place, character and action clips for every frame, then build up your movie.
