DIVISOR IS HOW MUCH YOU WILL SHARE THE AMOUNT OR ITEM

QUOTIENT IS THE ANSWER. IT IS HOW MUCH EACH WILL GET.



What is the dividend, divisor and quotient in each problem?

1. Jeremy has 18 slices of pizza. He shares it with his 3 friends. Each person got 6 slices.

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2. At a party, gummy bears were given out to 25 children. Each child got 5 gummy bears. There were 125 gummy bears in total.
