Visiting A Safari

Safari in Swahili language means **journey**. It is a journey in Africa that involves spending some time in the bush watching wild animals. So, basically, a safari is any trip into the **wilderness** to see wildlife.



African safari can be an **adventure** tour that spends some time in nature looking at animals and birds at African national parks. There are a number of national parks in Africa. Visitors get on a jeep or other

vehicles and the driver will drive around the safari. Here, visitors can see the animals up close.

As they drive along, visitors will see different wild animals living in their natural habitat. There are giraffes grazing on the grass, or elephants and zebra bathing and drinking the water.



If you are lucky, you might meet lion families or even see them face to face! But make sure not to touch any of the animals. Keep your distance from them!
