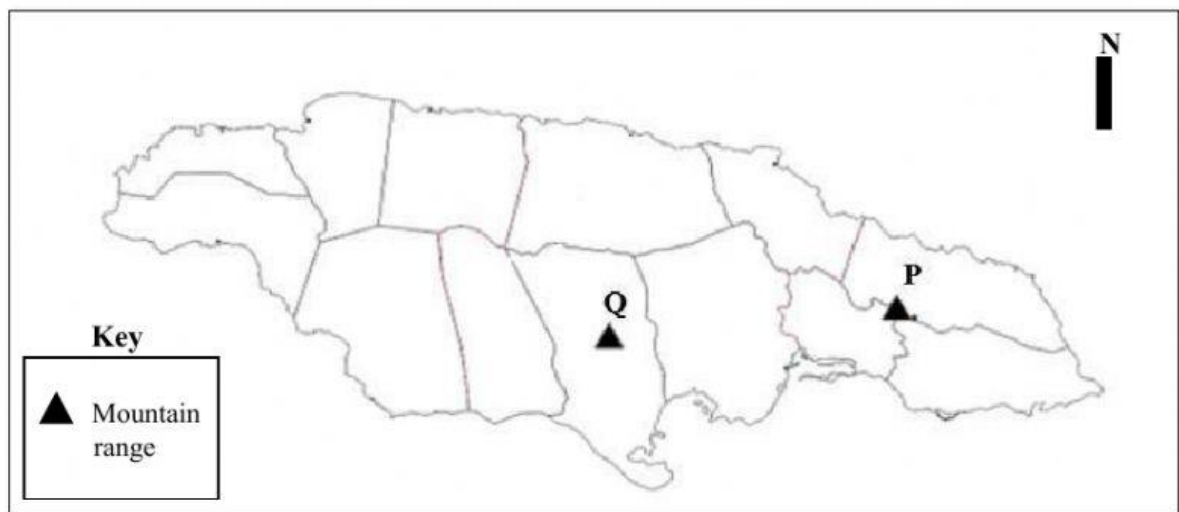




Map of Jamaica showing Two Mountain Ranges

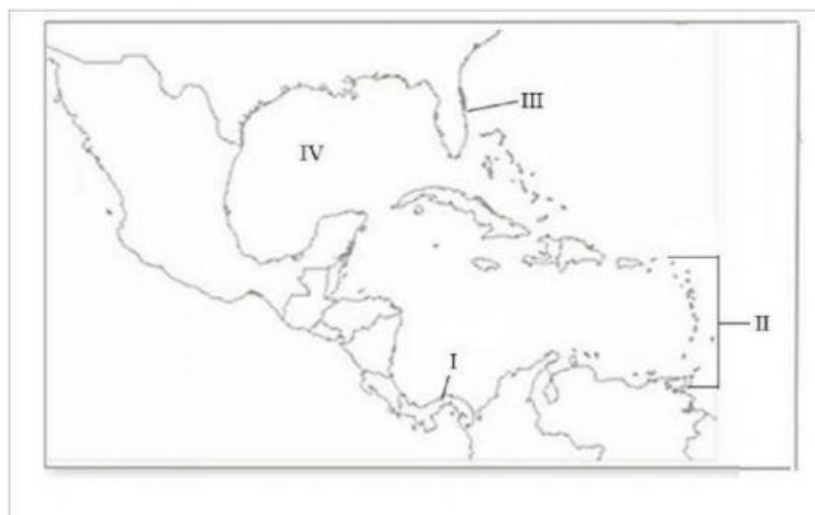
