

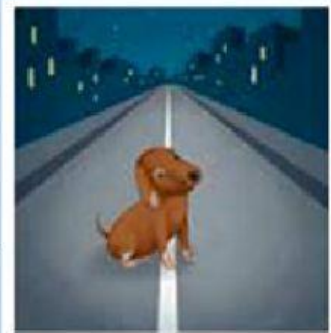
A NEW HOME FOR SOCKS

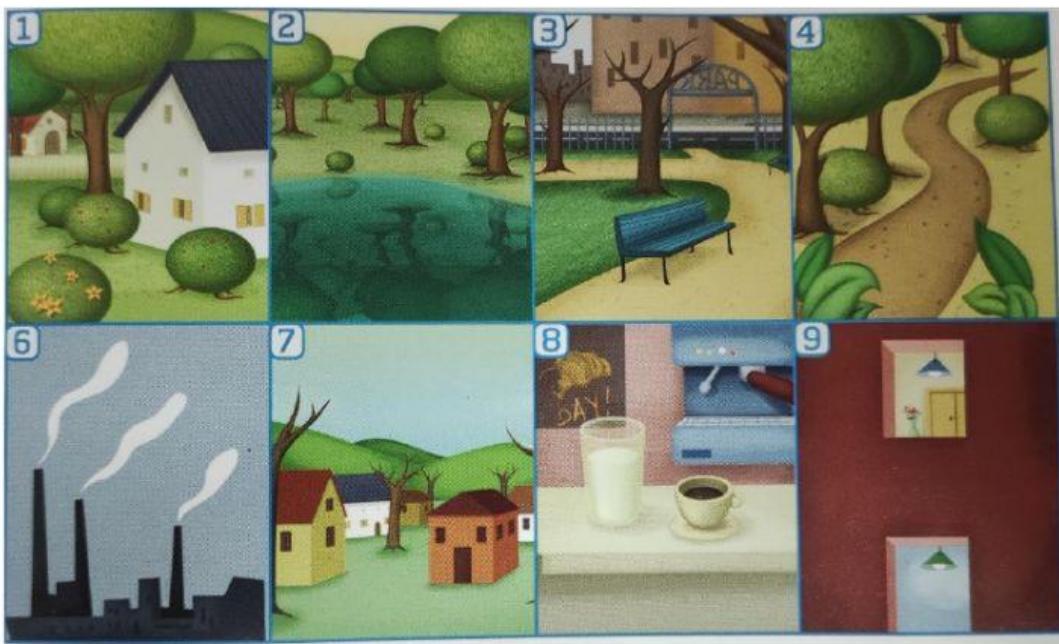
