PAST CONTINUOUS

(PRONOUN + WAS/WERE + VERB-ING)

AFFIRMATIVE

I **was** playing
 You **were** playing
 He **was** playing
 She **was** playing
 It **was** playing
 We **were** playing
 You **were** playing
 They **were** playing

NEGATIVE

I **wasn't** playing
 You **weren't** playing
 He **wasn't** playing
 She **wasn't** playing
 It **wasn't** playing
 We **weren't** playing
 You **weren't** playing
 They **weren't** playing

INTERROGATIVE

Was I playing?
Were you playing?
Was he playing?
Was she playing?
Was it playing?
Were we playing?
Were you playing?
Were they playing?

Was not = wasn't
Were not = weren't

Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't
Yes, you were. / No, you weren't
