BORNEO HOLIDAY, Land below the Wind

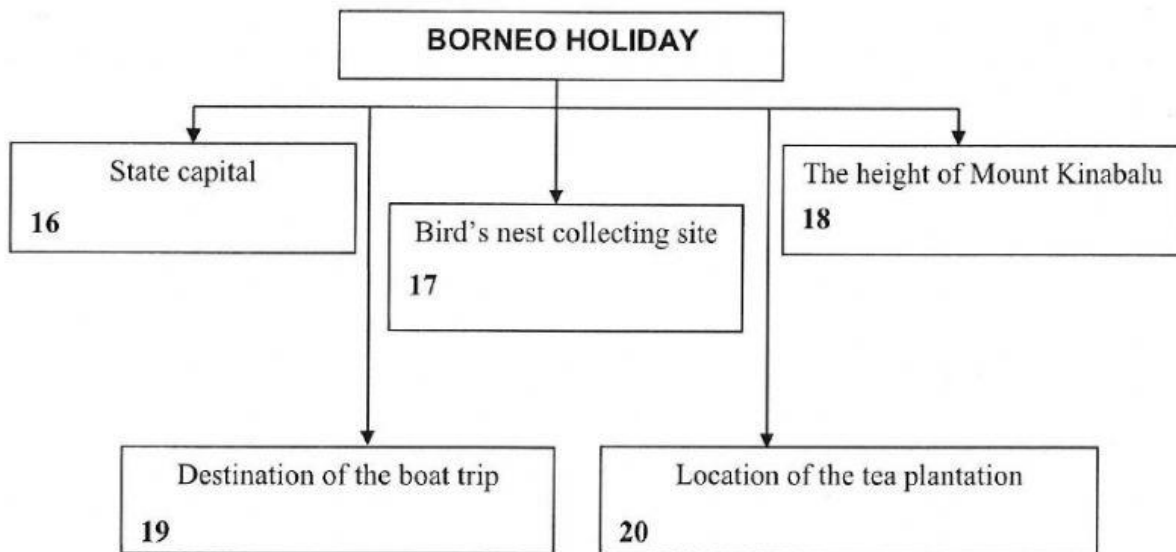


Day-by-day itinerary

Day 1	Morning arrival in Kota Kinabalu – state capital of Sabah in East Malaysia's Borneo - and transfer to a nearby beach resort. Afternoon at leisure to recover from your journey!
Day 2	Day relaxing in an idyllic beach resort just north of Kota Kinabalu, with a bike ride of the surrounding area and fishing villages for the energetic.
Day 3	Off into the interior with a short, but scenic, drive to Mount Kinabalu National Park. Nature hike in the Park with some spectacular views over the 12,000 feet mountain itself, before continuing on to a tea plantation at Kinabalu Valley for our overnight accommodation in a traditional style long house.
Day 4	Early start to see dawn rise over Mount Kinabalu from Signal Hill Observatory with an unusual and fun 'stream hike' as our morning's activity. In the afternoon we'll continue our journey to historic Sandakan Town on the East Coast.
Day 5	Morning visit to the fascinating Sepilok orang-utan rehabilitation centre and after lunch transfer to Bata Puti for a boat trip up river to our day's destination - a beautifully located, lake side Jungle Eco Lodge. Sunset boat trip on the jungle-lined Kinabatangan River.
Day 6	Morning in Danum valley and after lunch return drive to the east coast for a visit to the Madai Caves, famed as a bird's nest collecting site, and on to Tawau Hills Park for our overnight accommodation.
