Zero: If + Present Simple, Present Simple.

First: If + Present Simple, Future Simple (will/ won't).

Will – Be going to

Will	Be going to
- There's no milk. - Really? In that case, I <u>will go</u> and get some.	- There's no milk. - I know. <u>I'm going to go</u> and <u>get</u> some when this TV programme finishes.
- I think the Conservatives <u>will win</u> the next election.	- The Conservatives <u>are going to win</u> the election. They already have most of the votes.
