#### The solar system

There are eight planets in the solar system: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune. Mercury is the smallest planet, but Jupiter is the biggest. Mercury is the closest planet to the Sun, but Neptune is the furthest.



The sun is not a planet, it is a star. The sun is at the center of the solar system and all the planets go around the sun. The path that a planet takes as it moves around the sun is called its orbit. As the planets move around the sun, they also rotate, or spin, completing one day. As the planet faces the sun, it is daytime. When the planet spins away from the sunlight, it is night.

Pluto was once considered a planet, but is now called a "dwarf planet" because of its small size. Many of the planets also have moons which also revolve around them. The solar system is truly amazing!
