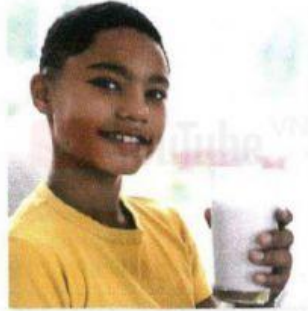

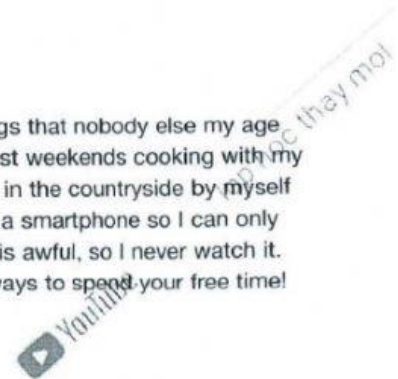
ANTON

A VISIT TO FLORENCE

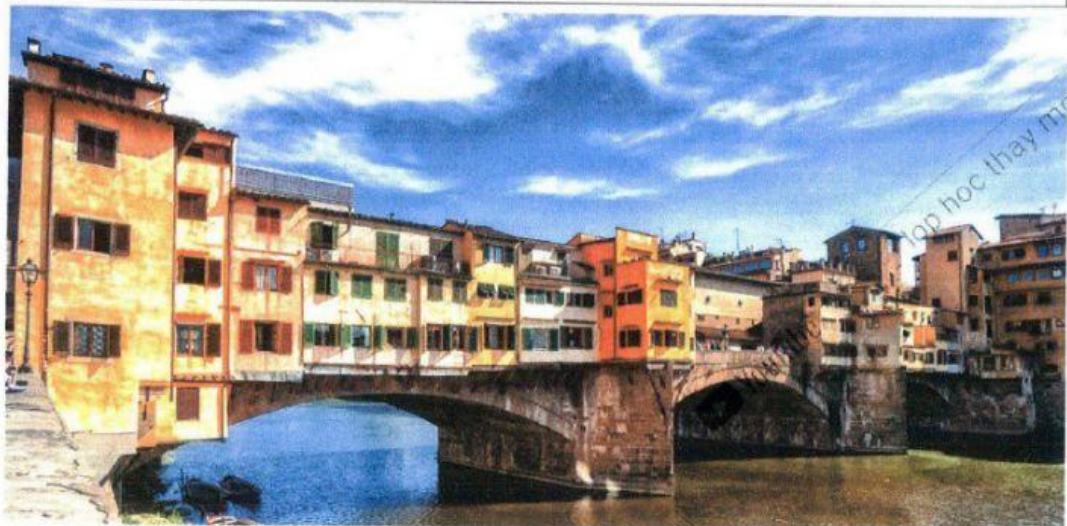
