Narrow tubes that carry sperm from the testicles to the urethra	
Organ that produces sperm and testosterone.	
Gland that produces a fluid that protects sperm.	
Involuntary muscular contraction that expels semen from the penis	
Hormone made in the testicles that stimulates the development of masculine sexual characteristics.	
It's the male sex organ and it contains the urethra.	
Sperm produced by the testicles + Fluids produced by the seminal vesicles and the prostate
