PAST SIMPLE

WAS / WERE + Past Participle of verb

Kate wrote a letter to me. (Active Voice)

A letter was written by Kate to me. (Passive Voice)

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

HAVE / HAS + BEING + Past Participle of verb

Kate is writing a letter to me. (Active Voice)

A letter is being written by Kate to me. (Passive Voice)

PRESENT PERFECT

HAVE / HAS + BEEN + Past Participle of verb

Kate has written a letter to me. (Active Voice)

A letter has been written by Kate to me. (Passive Voice)
