



Past Continuous Passive Voice

Robert **was buying** some milk when I saw him.

Some milk **was being bought** by Robert when I saw him.

Step 1: the object becomes the subject

Step 2: the verb to "be" replaces the main verb

Step 3: the main verb is written in the past participle

Step 4: the subject goes after the verb using "by"



I was playing football in the garden.	Football was being played by me in the garden.
I was not eating chocolate.	Chocolate was not being eaten by me.
Jim was writing letters on the computer.	Letters were being written by Jim on the computer.
Sue wasn't cooking dinner.	Dinner wasn't being cooked by Sue.
The dog wasn't chasing the cat.	The cat wasn't being chased by the dog.
We were buying newspapers at that moment.	Newspaper were being bought by us at that moment.
Was Jill opening the window then?	Was the window being opened by Jill then?
Were the children writing tests at school?	Were tests being written by the children at school?
